## **The impact**

- New resources purchased have enabled new sports to be reached by pupils including: handball, tri-golf and badminton
- Replacing old equipment with newer more age appropriate equipment has allowed children across both key stages to engage in high quality PE & games. Equipment such as hockey stick, footballs and basketballs are now all age appropriate.
- Ken Stimpson SLA has enabled children to compete in sports competition with other Peterborough schools (in both key stages). This has also allowed us to enter A, B and C teams.
- Key Sports ran a 'Sports Academy' club for the more able children. This ran weekly and included athletics and invasion games. The club allowed the children to engage with the technical side of these disciplines and think deeply about tactics.
- T-shirts were purchased for William Law Sports Leaders which has raised the profile of their role within the school. They have gone on to lead whole class PE lessons and were a major part of Sports Day.
- Release time for PE Cordinator has allowed for the following actions to take place:
  - Sainsbury's School Games – Silver Award
  - Training sessions with Sports Leaders
  - Observing and supporting staff
  - CPD courses ensuring good quality PE/games taught
