The Impact

- The Sports Partnership with Ken Stimpson continues to allow a large number of children from both KS1 and KS2 to participate in competitive sport. It has also provided extra training for play leaders and CPD opportunities for staff.
- The number of Sports Leaders have grown in the school to create a Sports Council – they have received new t-shirts and had a hand in acquiring new equipment.
- We have purchased the Cambridgeshire PE scheme of work which will be arriving early in the Summer term. This will be introduced in a staff meeting and will form the foundations of future PE/games teaching in 2017/18 academic year. This is in direct response to teacher questionnaires.
- The Level 6 PE Specialism Award has allowed the PE Coordinator to further develop their knowledge of the subject. The award is nationally recognised and supports the PE leader in developing whole school initiatives to drive good or better teaching and learning in the subject.
- The creation of a permanent PE/games teacher has allowed for the subject's profile to be raised considerably in school. This can be seen in pupil surveys and their increased enjoyment of the subject. The role has allowed for:
 - Team-teaching with every teacher in school – including opportunities to monitor, reflect and improve quality of teaching.
 - Adapting planning alongside class teachers
 - Increased social media surrounding PE/games
 - Increased levels of physical activity for all
