### Year 6 visit to Duxford Imperial War Museum, Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September

To launch our World War II topic, a visit has been arranged to the Imperial War Museum at Duxford. This visit is intended to give the children a first-hand experience of life during the war years and an opportunity to look around the museum.

This exciting experience will increase children's awareness of their past, enabling them to see first-hand, weapons and the effects of them in a war situation. It will allow the children to question whether war is ever necessary.

As part of the experience we would like children to come in wartime costume and bring a wartime lunch. Lunch items might include bread with jam, honey, beetroot or marmite; apples, pears, plums, tomatoes or carrots; rock cakes, plain fairy cake. Items such as meat, chocolate, crisps, bananas and lunch boxes were not readily available during the war, so please avoid these if possible. Suitable wrappers would be brown paper or greaseproof paper. If requested, the school caterer will provide a packed lunch for individuals who are entitled to free school meals.

Suggested wartime clothing might include:

- Boys – long socks, school shoes (no trainers), long grey or black shorts/trousers, plain shirt preferably white or grey, tank top, braces, plain waistcoat, flat cap and a winter coat.
- Girls – short socks, school shoes, skirt, blouse, pinafore dress, bonnet/straw boater, cardigan and a winter coat.

To cover the cost of coach travel and entrance fee, we ask for a contribution of £8.10 per child. Our preferred method of payment is via ParentPay, however the exact amount of cash can be paid to the school office. In line with school policy there is no charge for families in receipt of Pupil Premium.

We will be travelling by coach. We will be departing school at 8:30am and depending on the traffic on the A14, return to school at approximately 3.15pm.
