### Year 4 visit to East Midlands Airport

As you may be aware our topic this term, is 'Around the World'. To give the children first-hand experience of how an airport runs, we have arranged a Year 4 visit to East Midlands Airport 'Aerozone', on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2020. The Aerozone is the airport's educational centre, which offers a range of interactive activities for children to participate in and develop their understanding of travel. Children will also have the opportunity to visit the main airport and to experience the 'landside' [before check in] area of the airport. In the afternoon, we will be taking the children to the 'Aeropark'. This is situated on the other side of the airport with a view of the runway as well as having several real aircrafts for the children to go inside and look around. The visit will be immensely beneficial to the children for both their topic and literacy lessons this term.

We are planning to leave school at 8.00am and, traffic permitting, will be returning by 4.30pm. We will be travelling by private coach. This will mean that the children will need to be at school for 7:30am so that they can be registered and to ensure a prompt departure.

To cover the cost of coach travel and entry to the 'Aeropark', we are requesting a contribution of £11.30 per child. All payments will have to be made through ParentPay. In line with school policy there is no charge for families in receipt of pupil premium based free school meals. If you are in receipt of pupil premium free school meals, you will receive an email from Mrs Wardell to consent to your child travelling to and from East Midlands Airport to participate in this activity.

Please ensure that your child wears their school uniform, brings a waterproof jacket, a packed lunch, a bottle of water and some fruit for a snack. All food and drink should be in a rucksack. If your child normally receives a free school meal, the school caterer can provide a packed lunch on this day
