English

In writing, we will be continuing to develop phonic knowledge, teaching a range of new sounds from Letters and Sounds Phase 5. These skills will be applied through descriptive story writing, as well as speaking and listening skills through role play.

This term we will be focusing our narratives and recounts. We will pay particular attention to sentence structure and punctuation, as well as practising using adjectives and conjunctions.

Mathematics

We will be exploring number, teaching the children to count, read and write with numbers; to 20; in numerals and words.

We will learn more about addition and subtraction as well as practising number bonds to 20.

We will use practical activities to learn about measuring and 2D and 3D shapes referring to their properties.

Computing

We will become storytellers by producing our own video recordings.

We will begin to understand and use digital devices.

PE

In PE, we will be creating our own rainforest dance using routines and motifs.

We are going to use our team skills and learn how to catch and throw.

Art and DT

We are going to be investigating mixing colours to create our own palettes.

In DT, we are going to design and make our own woodland treehouses.

Music

In Music, we will be focusing on exploring pitch, notation and composition.

Science

In Science we are going to explore different plants.

Geography and History

We are going to identify the different continents around the world.

In History, we are going to study the history of different houses.

Rainforest

Autumn Term

R.E.

This term we will be learning about baptisms and birthdays. In December we will be learning about the first Christmas.

PSHE

We will be looking at new beginning and belonging, emotions, family and friends, and different strategies for getting on and not falling out.

English

We will use non-fiction texts to discover information about space, write a non-chronological report and also become reporters, as well as writing an exciting narrative.

We will focus on punctuation; question marks and exclamation marks and capital letters for people, places and days of the week. We will continue to use our Phase 5 phonics to help spell words in different tenses.

Computing

We will develop our understanding of internet safety. We will use paint tools to create pictures, as well as save, retrieve and print work.

P.E.

We will focus on balancing and sequencing through gymnastics. We will continue to develop team skills.

Art and DT

Immersing ourselves in our topic, we will be designing and constructing a space ship using a variety of materials.

Science

In Science, we will learn about materials and their different properties.

Mathematics

We will be focusing on number bonds to 20 and how they relate to subtraction facts.

We will be adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers to 50.

We will learn to tell the time to o'clock and half past.

We will compare, describe and solve practical problems for time, length and capacity.

R.E.

We will be learning about children from Christian, Jewish, Sikh, Muslim and Hindu families and discussing the similarities and differences they share.

PSHE

We will be focussing on working together and achieving goals, as well as healthy lifestyles.

History and Geography

In History, we will study Neil Armstrong and his achievements.
In Geography, we will identify human and physical features of the world.

Music

In Music, we will continue to be focusing on exploring pitch, notation and composition.

English

We will write an exciting narrative to show off all the skills we have learnt in Year 1.

In addition to this we will write instructions for building a house suitable for a range of minibeasts.

We will read a variety of mini beast themed poems and use these to inspire our own poetry.

Computing

We will be learning to word process short texts to show others. We will also be learning to record sound at and away from a computer. We will also continue our work on internet safety.

Art and DT

We will be creating our own clay minibeast creatures.

Science

We will be carrying out an investigation to classify animals.

Mathematics

We will solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.

We will recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

We will compare, describe and solve practical problems involving money.

Geography and History

In Geography, we will look at weather patterns and identify the four capitals of the United Kingdom.

In History, we will use drama to recreate historic events.
