Autumn Term 2019

In Maths lessons we will be:

- * learning our times tables up to 12 x 12.
- * ordering and comparing numbers beyond 1000.
- * rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
- * adding and subtracting numbers with 4 digits.
- * multiply 2 or 3 digit numbers with a 1 digit numbers.

In Music lessons we will be:

- * continuing to play our recorders.
- * exploring notation,
- * composition and sounds.
- * experimenting with music ICT using 'Playpad'.

In Computing lessons we will be:

- * designing and creating a medicine bottle and an app to present to members of the medical computing industries.

In English lessons we will be:

- * Writing an explanation text on how the digestive system works.
- * Writing a fiction story using correctly punctuated speech.

Creative Curriculum

We will be learning the key functions of organs and designing a representation of the digestive system using everyday objects. We will be comparing medical remedies from the past and present to cure the flu. We will also be creating our own model teeth.

In PE, we will be developing gymnastics skills, improving our fitness and agility, learning how to solve problems and the skills and techniques needed to play
