Dear Parent/Carers

Coronavirus Update – School closure to most pupils

Following on from my last update, I am now writing to let you know that **we have now been instructed to close the school to almost all children after this Friday, until further notice.**

As advised by the Government, we will do all we can to stay open for the children of key workers (e.g. NHS staff, Police, others in frontline services) and children with certain needs.

We are waiting for the Government to publish more information on what this means, but it would help us in the meantime if you could let us know if you think your child may fall into one of these categories. Please phone the school office or email office@williamlaw.peterborough.sch.uk with your child's name and class and what your role is if you are a key worker. We will be in touch again as soon as we are sure who this does apply to.

All other children will need to stay at home, so we ask that you do not send your child into school from Monday onwards.

Please note that this is a national closure – as you may have heard in the news – so while it is a challenging situation, we are not alone. We will re-open fully as soon as we can and will let you know when this is by Parentpay communication, Twitter and on the school website.

What we will continue doing while your child is at home

Your child's learning is of course important to us, so we will continue to help your child to learn.

We have now set home learning packs for every child, Reception to Year 5. Year 6 packs will go home at the end of today. You will be able to contact school by email and that can be sent onto teachers. If your child is currently not in school, we are making arrangements to get the packs to you.

If your child usually receives free school meals we will shortly be in touch once the Government has announced more on this.

Year 1 Phonics screening
Year 4 – Multiplication tests
