

Draw a map of the UK and identify all the places where historians have found evidence or artefacts from the Saxons or Vikings e.g. Sutton Hoo, Edinburgh, Winchester or Lindisfarne. Could you identify the Saxon kingdoms of Northumbria, Essex, Wessex and Mercia?

Find and research the meaning of 10 different Latin words.
