Dear Parents/Carers

Transition days were very successful. 89% of children attended. Some worried faces came into school but happy faces left at lunchtime. Staff also appreciated that quality time to get to know the children and had the opportunity to hear them read and do some 1:1 work. It was good to show the children the changes around school and I hope they feel more settled to return in September.

The Government will review schools re-opening on 11th August 2020. Assuming we are to have all children back, which is what we are expecting, school starts on Monday, 7th September 2020 for Years 1-6. New Reception children will start on Monday, 14th September 2020.

From September, school will be full time, Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 3.15pm. PPA will be covered by staff in year groups.

To ensure everyone's safety, we are staggering the arrival and collect times of the school day. Children should arrive at school between 8.15am and 9.00am. Children will need to be picked up between 3.00pm and 3.45pm. Please can only **one** person bring and collect, reducing the amount of adults at the school gates.

As advised in the July newsletter, the gates you need to use for dropping off and collection are:-

Reception at the reception gate (black gate at front of school).

Year 1 at Play Park gate

Year 2 at Play Park gate

Year 3 at the hall door

Year 4 at the hall door

Year 5 at Ken Stimpson gate, Upper School Playground

Year 6 at OSC gate

The Hive, Out of School Club will be running from 7.45am to 6.00pm in year group bubbles. Attendees have been advised where they need to drop off and collect from.

Please can I remind you that children cannot bring in toys or anything for show and tell at this time.

It is school policy that no sweets or treats are given out by the children when it is their birthday or after holidays. These will be sent back home.
