

Year 3 Knowledge Organiser – What is wonderful about Werrington?

Key Vocabulary

Aerial photograph	A photograph taken from an aircraft.
City	Any settlement with a cathedral.
Parish	An area that is under the care of the parish priest.
Population	The number of people that live in a settlement.
Rural	An area of land outside of the densely populated urban areas.
Settlement	A place where people live that can be categorised into villages, towns and cities.
Town	A built up area that is larger than a village but smaller than a city.
Urban	A densely populated built up area.
Village	An area that is larger than a hamlet but smaller than a town.



Sticky Knowledge

- Werrington is a residential area of the city of Peterborough.
- Werrington spans an area of two and a half square miles (6 km²) and has a population of 14,800.
- Werrington has held a summer carnival and bonfire and fireworks display every year since the 1970s. At the bonfire, two people made out of clay are set on fire, made by volunteers from the local Scout and Guide Association in conjunction with Werrington Primary School.
- Werrington Village Cricket Club plays in the local Huntingdonshire leagues throughout the summer and plays its home games at nearby Campbell Drive sports fields.
- Werrington is split into two distinct areas; Werrington Village and New Werrington.

Timeline

1086	Werrington was one of the only surrounding hamlets to be mentioned in the Domesday Book.
12 th Century	Werrington had a manor and a chapel.
13 th Century	Werrington gained a monastery, a mill and a court.
1853	Werrington and Walton were separated from the Paston parish.
1901	The population of Werrington was 724.
1929	Werrington became part of Peterborough.
1987	William Law was built.
