

## Year 1 Autumn Curriculum Map



### Where do trees grow? Purpose of the theme:

- To explore the environment around us, comparing and contrasting plants and local woodland, national forests and international rainforest.
- To understand our impact on the protection and sustainability of the world.



### English

#### Key texts:

Narrative (Fairy Tales)  
Instructions

#### Writing:

To say first and then write to tell others about ideas. To independently write sentences to form a short narrative.

#### Word Reading / Comprehension

**Outcomes:** Independently start sentences with a capital letter, leave spaces between words and end sentences with a full stop. Use 'and' to join sentences.

### Spelling

**Spelling Outcomes:** form most lower case letters in the right direction and of a consistent size. Use capital letters for names and places. Suffix 'ing' and 'ed'. Form digits 0-9. Learn some new ways to represent phonemes.

**Focus Words:** the, said, my, come, some, friend, your, they, by, of.

**Phonics:** ay, ou, ie, ea, aw, ir, ue, wh, ph, ew, oe, au, ey, a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e, u-e.

### Science

**Focus:** Plants.

**Outcomes:** Identify and name common plants. Find out what plants need to grow and stay healthy. Understand the importance of exercise, eating healthily and having good hygiene for humans.

### Maths

**Focus:** Place Value to 10, Addition and Subtraction, Geometry.

**Outcomes:** Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals. Identify one more and one less. Identify and represent numbers using different representations including a number line.

Represent number bonds to 20. Use addition, subtraction and equals signs.

Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.



### Humanities

**History Focus:** Label timelines with words or phrases such as: past, present, older and newer.

**Outcomes:** Children will learn to ask questions and use artefacts, pictures, stories and online resources to find out about the past.

### Geography

**Focus:** Name and locate the world's continents and oceans. Understand geographical similarities and differences.

**Outcomes:** Children will learn the names and locations of the seven continents and five oceans and will learn about the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom. Children will explore our local area and create a map with a key.

### Art and DT

**Art Focus:** Create a background setting and add flaps to support Gruffalo.

**Outcome:** Children will investigate and choose a setting and use DT skills to make a moving picture which can be set anywhere in the world.

**DT Focus:** Explore mechanisms.

**Outcomes:** Children will investigate joining methods and practise their scissor skills. They will design and make their own moving picture, based on their favourite fairy tale.

### Computing

**Focus:** Algorithms

**Outcomes:** To give their grown up instructions to make a model with 3-D objects.

### R.E

**Focus:** What do Christians believe God is like?

**Outcomes:** Identify what a parable is. Retell the story of The Lost Son and understand the concept of God as the forgiving father. Explain what the story of The Lost Son means to Christians.

### Music

**Focus:** Story time, exploring sounds. Seasons, exploring pitch.

**Outcomes:** Children will listen to and play high, middle and low sounds. They will create, listen to and perform varying sounds.

### P.E.

**Focus:** Outdoor - ball skills and team games. Indoor - Dance

**Outcomes:** Children will practise their throwing and hitting skills in a game.
