#### **Christmas Disco 8th December**

We are pleased to be hosting our Christmas disco again this year. All school children are invited to attend. The entrance fee is £1, payable on the door. Teachers supervise the children and the school asociation have a selection of drinks sweets and pocket money items to purchase. None of the lower school children will have had the opportunity to attend the disco so here is a brief explanation...

Children need to be dropped at the main entrance where they will pay their entrance fee then walk through the school to the main hall, where we host the disco. At the end of the disco, we ask parents to queue back at the reception, you will be let in to walk through to the hall where the child's name is called out and then leave via the fire doors.

We ask that parents take children's coats away with them and bring them back on collection as there is no where to store these in the hall.

The disco times for lower school (reception and years 1&2) 4.30- 5.30pm. middle and upper school (years 3, 4, 5, and 6) 6-7:30pm.

#### Winter dress down day - Friday 9th December

This day is the day that makes our bazaar so successful. Come to school in your winter wear, be it Christmas jumper or you cosiest winter outfit. Instead of a cash donation we ask you bring a donation for the Christmas bazaar. This can be items we can use for the many tombolas we run. So chocolates, bottles, books, toys or any item we can use as a tombola prize.

#### The Christmas Bazaar - Friday 16th December, 6-8pm

Our Bazaar is a mixture of tombolas and games with sweets, cakes and mince pies and tea coffee, hot chocolate and soft drinks on sale. We have a Santa's Grotto and a range of stalls and games. Our most popular being our jam jar tombola.

The tombolas we run are chocolate tombola, kids tombola, bottle tombola, general tombola and our most popular jam jar tombola. The games we run are Where's Santa?, Nerf Santa and the naughty elf, Play Your Cards right and Lucky dip. The year six students also run their own stalls in their classes.

Most tombolas and games are 50p a go. Entry to the Bazaar is 50p per adult. Corridors get quite crowded and so we ask all children's pushchairs are left in the buggy park in the main hall.

On the morning of the Christmas Bazaar we ask the children from lower school would bring in cakes or mince pies to sell that evening. (We will be asking middle and upper school to bring these for the Summer BBQ).

#### Santa's Grotto

Santa sets up his grotto in class 10 but due to the large demand, the queue starts in class 9. All children get to meet Santa and receive and gift for the small fee of £3.

#### Jam Jar Tombola

Each year we ask children to fill and decorate jars. The jars are filled with wrapped sweets, craft items, puzzles or any small item that fits. In the past, people have put in teddies, gift cards even and pound coins in a tiny jam pot. The decorations can be a simple or creative as you want. For each jam jar brought in the child gets their name added to a draw with the chance to win a chocolate Santa. The draw takes place the morning of the bazaar. Jam Jars can be brought to school from the 21st November.
