## Bake a cake with an adult

First decide what sort of cake to make and find a recipe. Can you find all the ingredients you need? Can you help to measure out the ingredients? What happens to the ingredients as you mix them together? How long does the cake take to bake? You could take some photos to show what you have made.

## Making 5

Using everyday objects (such as buttons, conkers, leaves etc) can you investigate how many different ways you can make 5? You could draw a picture to show what you have found.

## Phonics

What can you find in your house that starts with any of these sounds:  
g, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k

## Self-portrait

Look in the mirror. What colour eyes do you have? What colour hair do you have? Do you wear glasses? What are you wearing? Can you draw a picture of yourself. You could use colouring pencils, felt tips or paints.

## Nursery rhymes

Do you have a favourite nursery rhyme? Can you perform it to your family?

## Autumn

Go on a walk and look for signs of autumn. What can you see, hear, smell, touch or feel? Draw a picture of your findings or collect leaves, twigs or conkers and use these to make a picture.

## Favourite things

Learn how to take photos using a camera, phone or tablet. Can you take some photos of your favourite things?

## People who help us

Find out about someone who helps us - it could be a police officer, firefighter, supermarket worker, a parent. Can you draw a picture of that person and explain to an adult how that person helps us?

Ride a bike or a scooter to the park. How long does it take you?
