We have been extremely busy with our **All about the Weather Theme**,

The children have taken part in different weather experiments:

- making a cloud and a tornado in a jar
  - making instant ice and shaving cream rain clouds
- were just a few.

Rain gauges were made and hung outside and the children measured the rainfall daily and recorded their results.

We also looked at what animals appear in certain seasons such as lambs are born in the spring time and we discovered that during a mild winter hedgehogs can remain quite active and here's one to prove it!



So all in all the children have been very busy with the **All about the Weather theme.**

Moving forward during January we will be focusing on our new theme of **DISNEY**.
