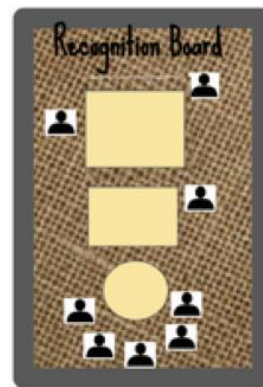

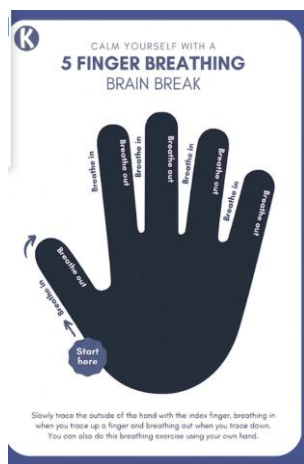

Snacks and Drinks

In EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2, pupils are provided with a daily snack of fresh fruit or vegetables through a government-funded scheme. From Year 3 onwards, pupils may bring a piece of fruit, vegetables, or a healthy cereal bar as a snack.

We are a nut-free school and ask that no nut products are included in snacks or lunchboxes. We have several children with severe nut allergies, and exposure to nut products could have life-threatening consequences.

As a school, we follow the School Food Standards. Therefore, we ask that children bring a healthy packed lunch if they are not having a school dinner. At the end of the newsletter, you will find some lunchbox ideas that you may find useful.

We also ask that your child brings a water bottle containing fresh water. Juice, squash and other sweetened drinks are not permitted due to their sugar content. In exceptional circumstances, where there is a medical need, permission may be granted as a reasonable adjustment. Please contact the school office if you would like to discuss this further.



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Parking

A reminder that parking on the roundabout is reserved exclusively for children or parents who hold a Blue Badge. Permission may be granted at the Principal's discretion in other exceptional circumstances. Please do not park on the roundabout or in the school car park between 8:15am and 4:30pm. If you are a Blue Badge holder and require access to the roundabout, please contact the school office to register and obtain access.

If you are dropping off or collecting children from clubs, including Choir or Sensory Circuits, please park on Twelvetree Avenue or in the community car park unless you hold a Blue Badge.
